The Postal History of Navarra in the 19th and 20th Centuries.

Pamplona to Madrid, 1st June, 1926.

The address side of this letter sent by the 'Banco Español de Credito' Pamplona, to 'Credit Lyonnais', Madrid, with the 25c Vacquer stamp machine cancelled, 1st June, 1926, is quite plain, and without any special features.

The whole of the reverse side of the envelope however is a large advertisement for the 'Ferias Y Fiestas De S. Fermín', due to take place between 6th and 18th July.

A machine arrival mark of Madrid is dated 2nd June and stretches across to top of the advert, fortunately not obliterating it. In addition to religious functions, full details are given of the various Corridas to be held. A most interesting document.
