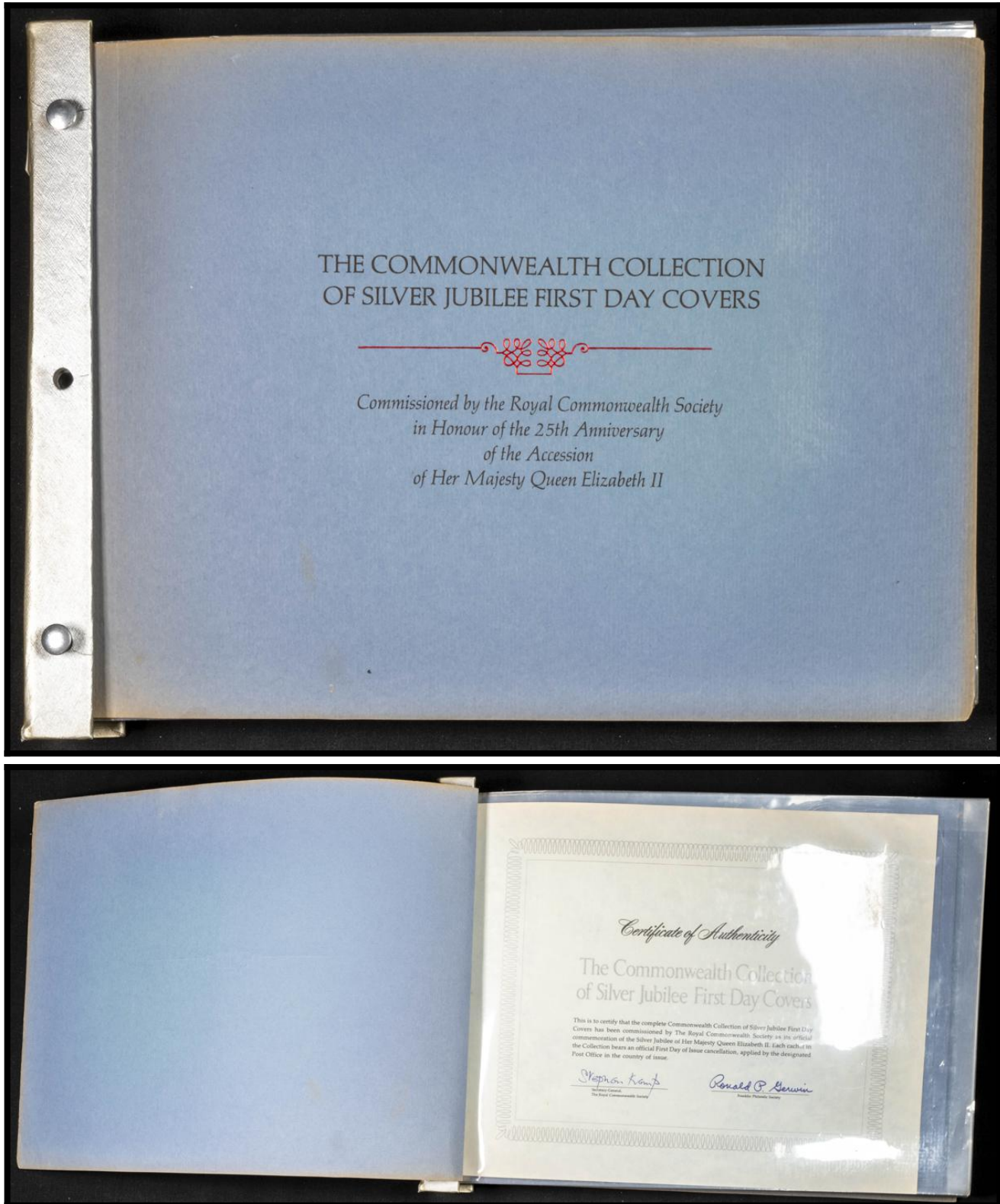

### Anguilla

The Silver Jubilee First Day Cover, an official commemorative of The Royal Commonwealth Society, bears two official Silver Jubilee stamps issued by Anguilla, a British Dependency and a member of the West Indies Associated States.

A British colony since 1966, Anguilla was brought into association with St. Christopher and Nevis in 1969. In February 1979 the island secured a new constitutional relationship, Anguilla as a British Dependency, but remaining in as a member of the Associated States of St. Christopher-Nevis-Anguilla. A very hot island, Anguilla is only 210 feet above sea level at its highest point.

Anguilla has issued two Silver Jubilee stamps to honor the anniversary of the coronation of the reigning Queen Elizabeth II. The one dollar and twenty-cent stamp portrays the Queen on board during the coronation parade. The four-cent stamp depicts a motor launch carrying Prince Philip ashore from the royal yacht Britannia at Anguilla in 1964.

The name was proposed to Anguilla by the official printer of mail cancellations, T. J. Scott. The name was approved by the Queen's Commissioner for the West Indies, and the post office in a government of the island.

### Antigua

The Silver Jubilee First Day Cover, an official commemorative of The Royal Commonwealth Society, bears the three official stamps issued by Antigua.

Discovered by Columbus in 1493 on his second voyage to the West Indies, Antigua derives its name from the Spanish of Santa Maria de la Antigua in Seville. Spain's dependence on the United Kingdom, Antigua is a crown colony of the United Kingdom.

All three of Antigua's official Silver Jubilee stamps appear on this cover. One of the three used stamps are the history and Queen Philip on royal coat in Antigua, while the other two stamps show the Queen coronation and also the Commonwealth. The two stamps show the Elizabeth II wearing the St. Edward's Crown.

The Silver Jubilee First Day Cover issued by Antigua with the official first day of issue in 1997, also bears the official coat of arms of the former Colony of Antigua, the design of which, representing the sugar industry, was the property of Antigua. It includes the coat of arms of the United Kingdom, with the motto: Dieu et mon droit.

The coat of arms is a principle between the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth.

### Ascension Island

An official commemorative of The Royal Commonwealth Society, this Silver Jubilee First Day Cover bears three official Silver Jubilee stamps issued by Ascension, a Dependency of the Royal Commonwealth of St. Helena established in 1974.

The twenty-five pence stamp, Prince of Wales, alluded to the royal yacht during the coronation in Westminster Abbey. The twelve-pence stamp shows the scene at Buckingham Palace on the day of the coronation. The portrait of the Royal Highness Prince Philip on the eight-pence value commemorates his 1957 visit to Ascension Island.

An important commemorative event in the northern Atlantic Ocean, Ascension Island was proclaimed as the British. Ascension Island has been the site of the Silver Jubilee.

This Silver Jubilee First Day Cover bears the official postage of Ascension, including three royal stamps, only through the Queen St. George Street to secure a postage between two days on its anniversary under the name of Ascension Island, the name appears at the top of the badge.

The name was proclaimed in Ascension Island at the post office of the island with the official first day of issue on February 7, 1997.

The Silver Jubilee First Day Cover, an official commemorative of The Royal Commonwealth Society, bears the two official stamps issued by Australia.

The Silver Jubilee First Day Cover issued by Australia with the official first day of issue in 1997, also bears the official coat of arms of the Commonwealth of Australia, the design of which, representing the sugar industry, was the property of Australia. It includes the coat of arms of the United Kingdom, with the motto: Dieu et mon droit.

The coat of arms is a principle between the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth.

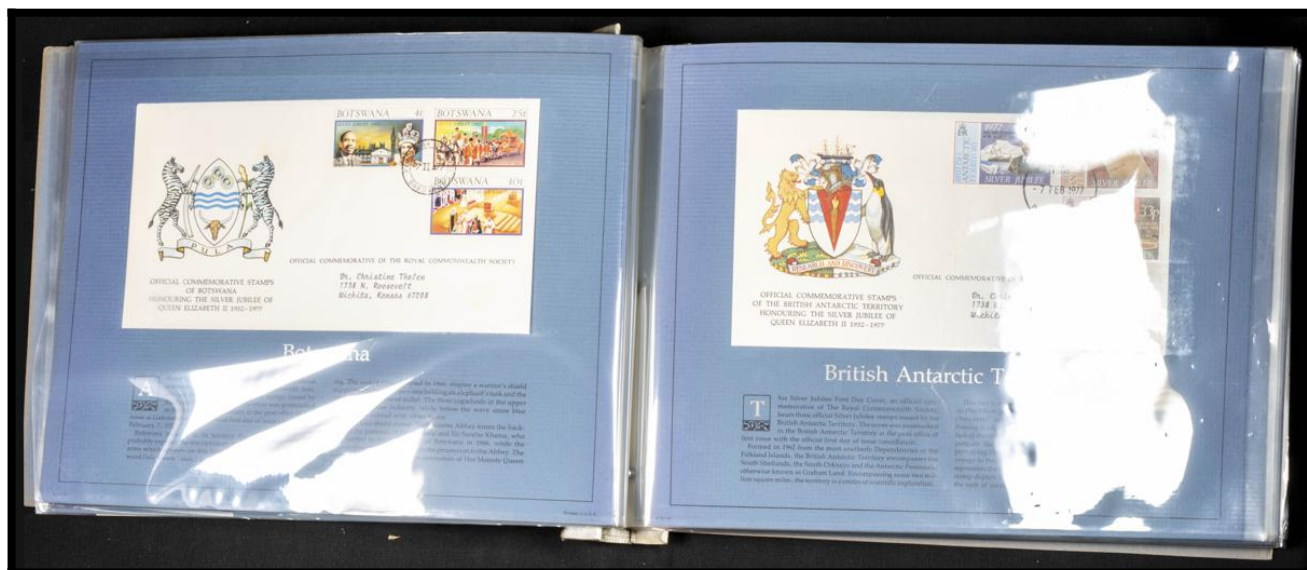
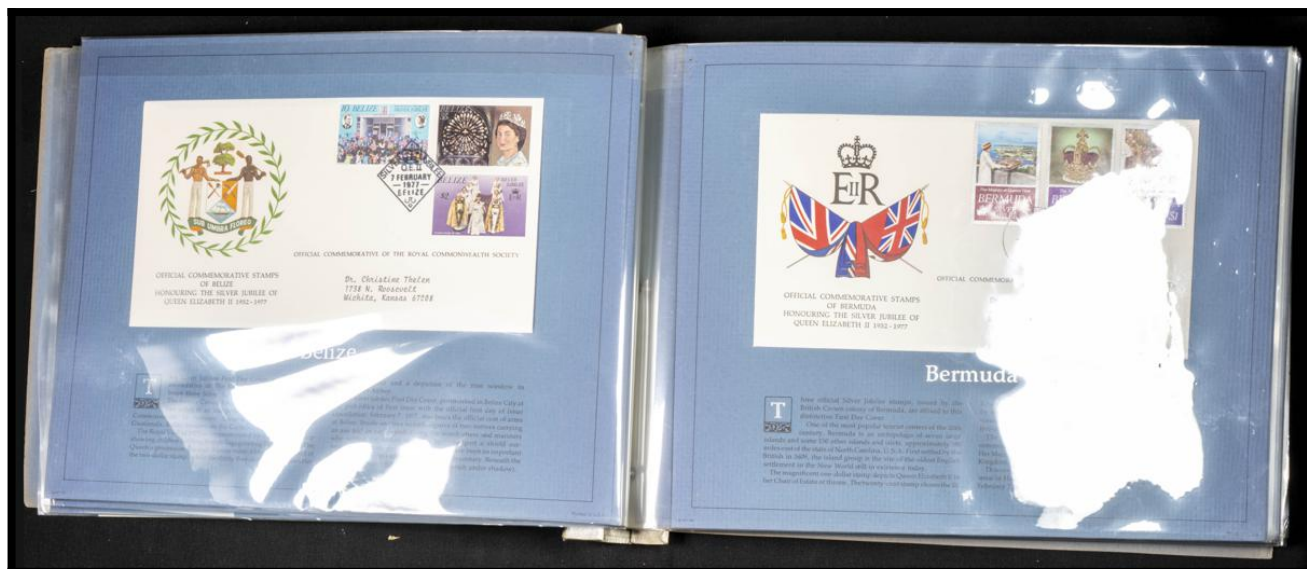
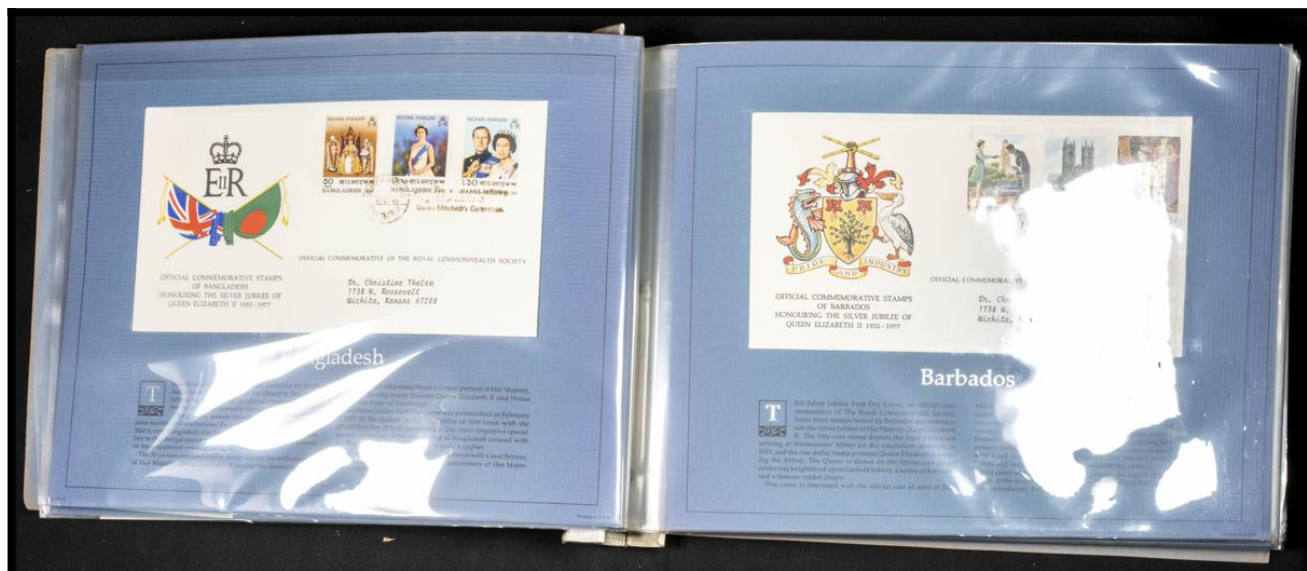
### Bahamas

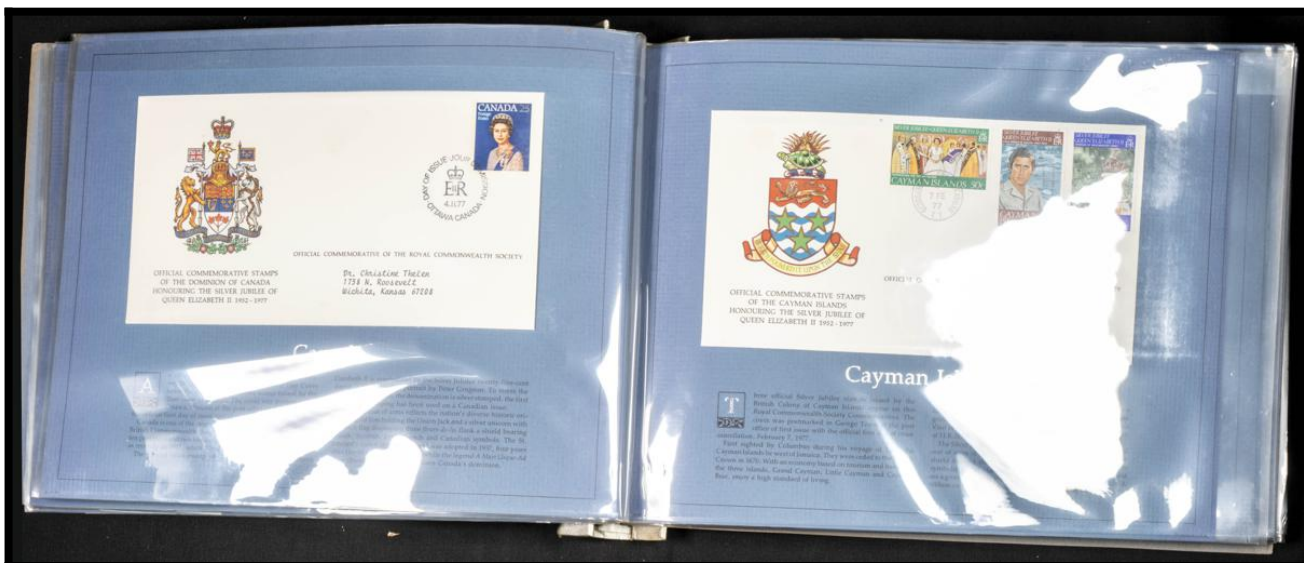
