The Postal History of Navarra In the 19th and 20th Centuries

The Spanish Civil war, 18th July 1936 – 1st April 1939.

Following the decree of November, 1936, the Authorities in Navarra were not slow to issue a 5c tax stamp for use on correspondence.
Before the end of the year, The Provincial Council validated an existing fiscal stamp for use as a postal tax stamp and these were employed throughout the Province.
These are not readily available used and do not seem to be very plentiful on cover.

This mint example reveals a colourful stamp in blue and red. (Perf. 11.1/2).
These were numbered sequentially, with the number printed in black.



The use of the former fiscal stamp was short lived and in 1937 a set of three stamps, specially prepared for postal tax purposes, was issued (perf. 11.1/2 and also imperf.)
These depicted:- 5c (green) Patriotic statue, 10c (blue) Church of St. Nicholas, 25c (dull red) Pamplona Cathedral. All stamps are inscribed "Por La Patria".
Again these stamps are not readily available used, but can be found on cover.
